### Exhibit Opening: 10th Annual Stonington Artists

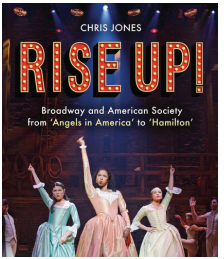
