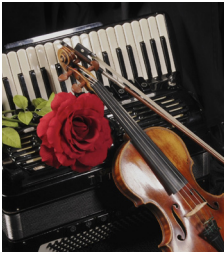

More Music Series: Glenn Kendzia

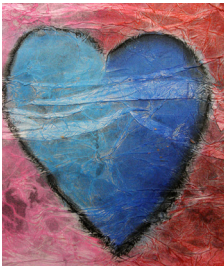
