Exhibit Opening: 4th Annual Celebrating Art in Autism Exhibit

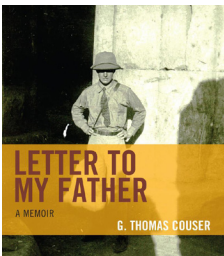
