Snapshot July 2022-June 2023

This past fiscal year, La Grua Center played a pivotal role in engaging our community through a vibrant and diverse lineup of concerts, lectures, and art exhibitions. Our Music Matters series celebrated its 13th year with exceptional performances by Hilary Castle, Ani Kalayjian, Octavie Dostaler-Lalonde, Lisa Marien, Dashon Burton, Maksim Shtrykov, Shannon and Matt Heaton, Sophie et Adam, Theodore Mook, Claudio Ragazzi, and Anita Graef. We showcased amazing pianists including **Amélie Fortin**, Marie-Christine Poirier, Zahili González Zamora, Artem Belogurov, Miloš Repický, Misuzu Tanaka, Michael Bahmann, Duo Stephanie & Saar, Julia Bady, Andrew King, and Jiayan Sun.

We had even more music and performances with Broadway's Christopher Faison, Mozart for Munchkins, 123
Andrés, and Elaine Bromka. Sponsored by the Stonington Village Improvement Association, we held outdoor concerts on the Stonington Commons Green featuring Sonia Bettencourt, James Harris, Matt Heaton and the Outside Toys, Ms. Bergin, and the U.S. Coast Guard Band.

We presented community speakers that focused on a variety of interesting topics including Slater Museum's **Dayne Rugh**, CT Poet Laureate **Antoinette Brim-Bell**, Movie Producer **Michael Barker**, Moromi's **Bob Florence**, arts educator **Vivian Zoë**, author **Alex Prud'homme**, and the Mohegan

Tribe's **David Eichelberg**.

La Grua Center's walls were filled with artwork from Stonington, Mystic, and Pawcatuck artists at our Annual Stonington *Artists* show. The *Portrait of Complexity* exhibit celebrated Hispanic artists of our region and beyond including Carlos Bautista Biernnay, Adrián Meyer, and Margarita Maxson. 3 Steps Forward, 2 Steps Back was a collaborative project that looked at the topic of social justice through various presentations, performances, and workshops. A pop-up exhibit *Fish School* featured an impressive sculpture from **D Derek**. The visually stunning exhibit Winterlude from Gallery One CT brought together a diverse group of contemporary artists from the Connecticut shoreline. High school students from Stonington, Westerly, Ledyard, Wheeler, and Fitch, inspired us through our *Emerging Artists* exhibit. We created Artists Supporting Artists, fostering a dialogue between these students and local professional artists. Our **Postcard Art Project** filled our space and allowed us to bring in 80 students for a virtual bilingual field trip from Harbor Elementary School. For the crowd favorite *An* Expressive Brush, Anne Fix and Jim Quinn brilliantly curated a retrospective of the life and art of Margaret Triplett.

We continued our commitment to children with four **Youth Art Workshops** during Halloween, the holidays, Earth Day, and summer. Talented local artists along with volunteers from **Yellow**

Farmhouse Education Center, Stonington Community Center, New England Science and Sailing, Denison Pequotsepos Nature Center, Public Art for Racial Justice Education (PARJE), Hispanic Alliance of Southeastern Connecticut, and Expressiones Cultural Center shared their expertise with young budding artists during these workshops. Adults were able to connect with their artistic side during our sold-out Memoir Writing, Printmaking, and Pottery workshops. With the Ocean Community Chamber of Commerce and the **Town of Stonington**, we offered a free children's workshop where over twenty buoys were painted for the annual Stonington Lobster Trap Tree.

By the Numbers

We presented 23 in-person concerts including 6 free concerts; 14 lectures, films, and panel discussions, together with another 10 from our neighboring nonprofits; 8 art exhibitions; our 13th annual Fine Art & Craft Show/Sale; 4 youth art workshops; 4 weekly music, drum, yoga, and dance classes; and 1 Stonington Candidates Forum—welcoming nearly 7,500 visitors through our doors. More than 7,800 people viewed our online programs on La Grua Center's YouTube channel.

Partnership

We continued to value and build upon our important relationships with our closest neighbors—the Stonington Free Library, the Stonington Historical Society, James Merrill House, the Stonington Garden Club, the Arts Café Mystic, and the Mystic Film Festival, which all regularly use our space for their public programming. We collaborated with the Stonington Harbor Yacht Club and SVIA for outdoor music and other events. We are active members of

Stonington Nonprofits, the Stonington Borough Merchants Association, and the Cultural Coalition, as well as our three closest chambers of commerce—Greater Mystic, Ocean Community, and Eastern Connecticut. Thanks to our collaboration with WMNR Fine Arts Radio and Christopher Greenleaf, many of our concerts were recorded live for radio broadcasts.

Grants and Funding

The past fiscal year La Grua Center received a Connecticut Cultural Fund Operating Support Grant and a Quick Grant from Connecticut Humanities; a General Operating Support for Theaters and Performing Groups Grant, a Supporting Arts Grant, and a Connecticut Arts Endowment Fund Grant from Connecticut Office of the Arts; a grant from the Chamber of Commerce of Eastern Connecticut Foundation for our youth art workshops; a grant from the Katherine Forest Crafts





Foundation for our adult art workshops; a grant from the Dominion Energy Charitable Foundation in support of our Music Matters opening concert; and sponsorship from the Chelsea Groton Foundation for our affordable family concerts. 
