# Snapshot July 2023–June 2024

During the past fiscal year, La Grua Center was at the heart of the community's cultural life, offering a lively and diverse schedule of concerts, talks, art exhibitions, and educational programs. Our Music Matters series featured exceptional performances throughout the year, including the **Orpheus Guitar Duo**,

cellist **Gabriel Cabezas**, multi-Grammy nominated **Hermitage Piano Trio**, as

well as **Ivan Gusev**, **Marin Rothfritz**, and **Jiayan Sun**. We also enjoyed performances by **Peregrine Road**, **Megan Weikle** and **Allan Conway** in *Songs of Love*, **Duo Stephanie & Saar** in *Une Fête Française*, the **Balourdet Quartet** in *Deepest Dedication*, and **Olga Vinokur** and **Amandi Azikawe** performing Shostakovich. The series concluded with remarkable performances by the **Neave Trio**, **Hilary Castle**, and **Ani Kalayjian**.

We had even more music and performances with Grammy-winner **Nicole Zuraitis**, family concerts with **Mozart for Munchkins**, **Manguito**, and the **Yale Whiffenpoofs**. Sponsored by the **Stonington Village Improvement Association**, we held outdoor concerts on the **Stonington Commons**

**Green** featuring **The USCG Jazz Band**, **Twisted Pine**, **Yeisson Villamar**, **Calliope Brass**, and **Cold Chocolate**.



**Sam Quigley** shared art and the future of the Lyman Allyn Art Museum, while **David**

**Schulz** captivated audiences with “The Library” pop-up art event. **Nakai Northrup** spoke about the Pequot Museum and **Kandie Carle** gave a Gilded Age fashion show. The year also featured discussions including **Tim Love** and **Randy Bean**'s exploration of truth in the social media age, **Kolton Harris** and **Yexandra Diaz** reminding us of the transformative power of language and art, **Tom Verde**'s talk on historic boats, **Ian Cooke**'s gardening masterclass, and **Gary Anderson**'s insights into the restoration process of the Watch Hill Carousel.

Throughout the year, La Grua Center hosted a series of art exhibitions that highlighted both local and international talent. We began with **Stonington, Mystic**, and **Pawcatuck** artists at our *Annual Stonington Artists* exhibit, showcasing the creative prowess of our community. Haitian-American and Norwich resident **Samson Tonton**'s *The Soul Cries Out* inspired us to reimagine nature, love, and self. We celebrated our 15th year and the legacy of **Maurice and Winifred La Grua** with a dedicated exhibit that honored their enduring influence on the community. In the winter, brought the evocative *Absence* exhibit by Honduran artist **Josué Orellana**, stirring deep reflections on presence and memory. High school students from **Stonington, Westerly, Ledyard, Wheeler, and Fitch** inspired us through

the *Emerging Artists* exhibit. As part of this exhibit, we continued our *Artists Supporting Artists* program, which fostered a dialogue between these students and local professional artists. The year concluded with a retrospective of the life and artwork of Old Lyme art teacher **Lee Dadalt**.

We continued our commitment to children with four **Youth Art Workshops** during Halloween, the holidays, Earth Day, and summer. Talented local artists along with volunteers from **Yellow Farmhouse Education Center, Stonington Community Center, New England Science and Sailing, Denison Pequotsepos Nature Center, and Expressiones Cultural Center** shared their expertise with young budding artists during these workshops. Adults were able to connect with their artistic side during our popular **Draw That Jazz** workshop led by **Tom Frohnaphel**. With the **Ocean Community Chamber of Commerce** and the **Town of Stonington**, we offered a free children's workshop where over twenty buoys were painted for the annual Stonington **Lobster Trap Tree**.



## By the Numbers

We presented 23 in-person concerts including 6 free concerts and 2 family concerts; 12 lectures, films, and panel discussions, together with another 10 from our neighboring nonprofits; 7 art exhibitions; our 14th annual Fine Art & Craft Show/Sale; 4 youth art workshops; and 4 weekly music, drum, yoga, and dance classes—welcoming nearly 8,200 visitors through our doors. More than 4,000 people viewed our online programs on La Grua Center's YouTube channel.

## Partnership

We continued to value and build upon our important relationships with our closest neighbors—the **Stonington Free Library, Historic Stonington, James Merrill House, the Stonington Garden Club, the Arts Café Mystic, the CT Early Music Festival, and the Mystic Film Festival**, which all regularly use our space for their public programming. We collaborated with the **Stonington Harbor Yacht Club** and **SVIA** for outdoor music and other events. We are active members of the **Stonington Village Cultural District, the Stonington Borough Merchants Association, and the Cultural Coalition**, as well as three chambers of commerce—**Greater Mystic, Ocean Community, and Eastern Connecticut**. Our recent collaboration with WMNR Fine Arts Radio and Classical 95.9 WCRI, has enabled the broadcasts of our live recordings.



## Grants and Funding

La Grua Center received a General Operating Support for Theaters and Performing Groups Grant, a Supporting Arts Grant, and a Connecticut Arts Endowment Fund Grant from **Connecticut Office of the Arts**; a Quick Grant from **Connecticut Humanities**; a grant from the **Chamber of Commerce of Eastern Connecticut Foundation** for our youth art workshops;

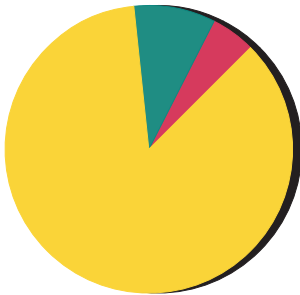
